Such barriers may include limited after-hours access to primary care providers, inability of parents to leave work to take children to office visits, transportation to appointments and school policies requiring sick children to leave campus.

Martin County Hospital District and Family Clinic is pleased to offer the convenience of having our providers available to see students without leaving their campus.

Through telehealth services, students are now able to see a provider at Martin County Family Clinic during school hours without leaving campus. Students who enroll in the school based program will have access to evaluations and certain lab testing. Providers are able to perform exams facilitated by the school nurse to diagnose and treat symptoms or illness by using state of the art telehealth equipment. This service is also available for employees of the school district.

Enrollment

It is easy to enroll in the School Based Clinic at your child's campus. Just complete the enrollment process by completing the online forms located on the Martin County Hospital District's website. You will need to provide your child's information, your contact information, insurance details and complete the consent to treat your child by telehealth services provided by Martin County Family Clinic and its providers. You may also enroll by completing the enrollment packet provided and submitting to the Martin County Family Clinic during our regular business hours, Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.
